What am I auditioning for?

You are auditioning for the concert band that meets as a class each day during the school year. If you are choosing to participate in the Lincoln-Way Marching Band, your audition will also be used to assist with part assignment placement and role assignment.

How do I sign-up for an audition?

Just add your name to the list your band director has (or will have), then complete and submit an audition video during the submission window (February 10-24).

What will I play?

- 1) *The two musical etude excerpts for your instrument.*
 - a. *For percussion, a snare etude excerpt and a mallet etude excerpt.*
- 2) *Pre-selected lines of the high school ILMEA scale sheet.*

The music looks hard, should I audition?

Yes! *Please understand that the music is challenging! Incoming freshman should prepare and record as much of the music as possible, but please don't worry if you are not able to prepare all of it.*

All students planning on joining band next year should audition. The audition will be used for concert band placement for next school year, as well as marching band part assignment and role assignment.



When do I find out the results?

We will post the results on the Lincoln-Way Music website approximately two to three weeks after all the auditions are completed (www.lincolnwaymusic.org).
