



Excessive absences from rehearsal will have an effect on a student's eligibility to perform or participate.

Competitive Show "Alternates"

- Since there are a limited number of spots in the competitive production, the LWMB uses an "alternate" system.
- If you are an "alternate" you will share and learn a performance spot with another performer and alternate performance events.
- Everyone will have a role, but the LWMB Band Directors decide that role based on needs of the competitive production.
- Not every member will be marching, spinning, or performing in every minute of the show but we are creating a production that includes everyone.
- All students enrolled in the LWMB are members in full standing and are required to pay the full cost of registration to be eligible for participation.




What it actually costs to join the LWMB

LWMB Organizational Cost per student: \$1,900 per student

*This is **NOT** the amount we are asking you to pay, this is what it costs the organization per student to operate this season.

What it actually costs to join the LWMB

- This \$1,900 cost is subsidized by multiple facets:
 - o LWMB Events & Fundraisers
 - Lincoln-Way Marching Band Sponsorship Program
 - Lincoln-Way Marching Invitational
 - LWMB Performance(s) in Momence Parade
 - Lincoln-Way Marching Band Community Night
 - Spirit wear sales
 - o Previous year surplus
- To be eligible to receive this subsidy there is a volunteer requirement from each family

Financial Obligations

- 2024 Performance Level Participation Fee: \$750
 - o Intent to Participate: \$150 Due 5/1
 - o Payment 2 \$150 Due 6/1
 - Payment 3 \$150 Due 7/1
 - o Payment 4 \$150 Due 8/1
 - o Payment 5 \$150 Due 9/1
- 2024 BOA Travel Fee: \$50-\$100 (Provisional)

There are logistical considerations that could require some expense with this year's scheduled travel (rental space, overnight, meals, etc.) Through sponsorships and fundraising, we will actively be working to raise enough funds to decrease or eliminate the responsibility of this expense to families.

Financial Obligations

 - Instrument & Equipment Rental (\$80, Brass/Percussion/Guard/Bass Clarinet/Tenor Sax)

Instrument Rental

- Brass/Bass Clarinet/Tenor Sax:
 - o \$80 rental fee
 - Trumpets, Mellophones, Baritones, Contra (Tuba), Bass Clarinet, Tenor Saxophone(s)
 - Goes to maintenance and upkeep of equipment
- Color Guard & Percussion:
 - o \$80 rental fee
 - Goes to maintenance and upkeep of equipment
- Pay rental fee in LWMB Charms
 - Will be assigned once instrumentation is confirmed

LWMB Volunteer Policy

We need your help!

Volunteering is essential to the success of the LWMB program.

The LWMB is able to host various events which allows us to keep participation fees at a reasonable level and to provide our students with the best possible experience. Every season is a little different, so these requirements may change from season to season.

Volunteer (Fundraising) Requirement

There are several major fundraising events that provide a subsidy to the actual overall cost of the LWMB experience. There are requirements for volunteering in order to be eligible to take advantage of the subsidized pricing.

Each LWMB family is required to volunteer (2) shifts from the Following:

LWMB Community Night (late August)
Frankfort Fall Festival Parking Assistance (Labor Day)
Irishfest (March)
LWMB Field Show Invitational (middle of October)
WGI Regional (February/March)

Families who do not participate will be assessed the unsubsidized cost to participate.

Note: Any family may have a different person work a required shift on their behalf.

There are age requirements for some volunteer positions.

Volunteer (Service) Requirement

Each LWMB family is expected to volunteer to signup for at least one service related job for the LWMB program: These positions include, but are not limited to:

Events (Leadership Camp, Band Camp, Travel); **Supervisory Needs** (chaperoning, Color Guard Rehearsal support); **Logistics** (Truck Driving, Show Props, Field Crew, Uniforms); **Uniforms** (Sewing, Altering, Measuring, Maintenance) **Communications** etc.

* You will receive an email notifying you of when signups for these positions are available. Signing up is first come first serve. You may be reassigned depending on the needs of the organization.
