- Registering for the Trip
 - Register in the **Bob Rogers Travel** “IPS” system by **November 24, 2023**.
 - There is a “Deposit” due of \$250 on **December 1, 2023** to secure a spot on the trip.
- Registration, Trip payments, Payment plan
 - Payment schedule and all payments are handled only by **Bob Rogers Travel** company.
 - Neither L-W #210, nor the LWMB, will collect or process your payments.
 - The LWMB will only assist in processing “I.F.A.” payments to the travel company.
 - IFA funds are not available to be used for the **December 1st** payment.

Chaperones

 - Being a chaperone is a **FULL TIME** responsibility. You will be “on duty” the entire trip, assisting with the logistics and supervision of the students.
 - We will only be taking an estimated 20-30 chaperones on the trip.

Financial Obligations

- Payment Methods
 - **Bob Rogers Travel** will process/collect all trip payments
 - Use of a Debit/Credit card is required; no personal checks
- “I.F.A.” – Individual Family Account
 - You cannot use “I.F.A.” funds to pay the **Deposit**.
 - After the Deposit, you can use “I.F.A.” funds to pay for the entirety of the trip cost.
 - Both the LWMB and the school music booster organizations offer options for fundraising!
 - Each one is an opportunity for students to raise their own funds to pay for the trip!

ToR Trip Raffle
